LIFE EXPERIENCE AND TRANSFER OF CREDITS

All information must be submitted by class #3 to be considered for eligibility. No exceptions!

Texas University of Theology grants life experience credits for professional and ministerial experience, and transfer of credit hours for studies taken in other colleges and learning institutions. When the student submits all the necessary documentation with a \$50.00 evaluation fee, an evaluation will be done, and the student will receive the results in writing. Please submit valid documentation of your life experience, together with the following information, if applicable:

- Resume of professional and ministerial experience
- Official transcripts from other learning institutions (religious and secular)
- Letters of Recommendation
- Certificates, Diplomas, Awards
- Books, Articles written by you
- Missionary trips
- Description of pastoral and leadership ministry

LIFE EXPERIENCE AND EVALUATION FEES

Evaluation application: \$50.00 (non-refundable)

Life experience credits: \$10.00 per credit

Example: 30 credits X \$10.00 = \$300.00 + \$50.00 evaluation application30 credits is equivalent to one (1) year of study (\\$1,350.00)

A savings of \$1,000.00

It is very important that you submit all the documentation for evaluation with the \$50.00 fee together at the same time. This information will allow us to calculate which level of study you are eligible to enroll for. We cannot accept incomplete documents. It is necessary that all transcripts from other learning institutions be official transcripts. We cannot accept copies.



2023 - 2024 DOCTORAL PROJECTS SUMMARY

Doctoral Project Fee:

\$125.00 for all Doctoral Level students

You will choose one of the options below for your Doctoral Project grade. If you are a PHD student, you must choose a different project than your DMIN level project. Project types cannot be repeated.

OPTION 1: Write a Dissertation

• Doctor of Ministry (D.Min) 100 – 110 Pages

• Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) 150 – 160 Pages

- A mentor will be assigned to you and will assist you through the writing process.
- Option 1 includes an additional fee for **Dissertation Binding of \$100** (Due when submitting your project). Your final dissertation will be professionally bound in a hard, leather cover, embossed in gold with the school logo and your name.

OPTION 2: Prepare a Teaching Message

Students will complete a set of assignments, to include:

- Prepare teaching notes
- Create a PowerPoint presentation
- Prepare a note taking sheet for the audience
- Record your live teaching for grading

OPTION 3: Prepare a Curriculum

- Example: New Leaders Class, Marriage Building Class, Evangelism Preparation
- The curriculum will be created for a 4-6 week cycle that could be taught in a church
- PowerPoint slides for each week's subject
- Create a teacher's guide and student's guide
