Dave Wallace, Jr was born on August 26, 1964 in Richmond, VA to Gladys and David Wallace, Sr. He is the youngest of three children. He was raised in the inner-city of Richmond, VA in the Giplin Court projects. His parents were divorced by the time he turned 14 years old following his father’s chronic struggle with alcoholism. To this day he is passionate about seeing men healed. It is his desire to mentor 500 men in his lifetime.

Pastor Wallace married Shirley Ann [Smith] of Dudley, England on July 1, 1995 in New Orleans, LA. He is the father of David III, Otische and Deztiny. He still remembers that Wednesday night service on February 14, 1990 (Valentine’s Day) in Norfolk, VA when he committed his life to Jesus Christ and asked Him to “be mine”. He has never looked back since his call to ministry.

In May of 2004, he received a Bachelor’s of Arts degree from Northwest University with honors; Organizational Management, He graduated with an Associates of Arts degree from the New Orleans School of Urban Missions in June 1997; Urban Missions.
