The Thirst for The Word in Africa Yuseff Howard, D.Min.

Jesus commanded to "Go and Make Disciples of all Nations"; so, go we did! I traveled to Uganda and Rwanda this past March. It was a mission to introduce REAP International and the Discipleship Program that we offer. Many of the individuals did not know what to expect other than that they would take a Teaching Certificate Exam. Now, this may sound simple in words, but it proved challenging for all who took the test. Part of my introduction to them was that their showing up was a passing grade in the eyes of our Father. The desire to learn what they did not know and acknowledge that maybe what they thought they knew was lacking was a blessing in itself.

In Uganda, the testing started off challenging, but with the Holy Spirit and some encouragement, I am pleased with the outcome. There were over 50 people who signed up to take the tests. What we did not know is that 90% were refugees and did not speak English. We adjusted to accommodate for this but then realized that many had little to no formal education. This proved to be problematic. I felt that if we got ten to complete the tests, this would be a success for the situation.

The second day came, and I did not think many would show. I was proven wrong. Almost all came back. After a full day of testing and extremely tired individuals, I am pleased to say that almost all returned.

Rwanda had over 70 participants. It was a good showing for their thirst and hunger for God's Word and an increased knowledge of themselves.

Combined, there was over a 65% passing rate. Both groups were very excited to hear about the K12 Schools and also how they can further their education with REAP through graduate and post-graduate courses. One precious moment was when I received a call that a church in Uganda would begin a Children's Ministry for the many children that I met near the church! Our mission is to reach all, including the children, and this was done!
